



Standing Rules District 28 Conference

- 1. The Presiding Officer of the Conference is the District Governor.
- 2. Voting members of the District Conference shall be:
 - The elected officers of the District Board (i.e. Governor, Lt. Governor, Treasurer, Area Directors)
 - Clubs represented by delegates or proxies.
- 3. Only those officers and delegates (or proxies) certified by the credentials committee as voting members of the conference may make motions or vote. To exercise these privileges, a voter must wear the conference badge and identification to all meetings and shall occupy one of the seats reserved for voters.

Delegates who carry proxy votes will be issued proxy identifications.

- 4. Transfer of voting privileges from a delegate to an alternate can only be made through registration with the Credential Committee.
- 5. To obtain the floor, a member will rise, address the chair, state her or his name and club.
- 6. No one may speak more than twice on the same question, no more than once if someone who has not spoken wishes to do so, no more than two (2) minutes at a time.
- 7. A time limit of 20 minutes shall be set on discussion of any one subject.
- 8. A delegate presenting a candidate from the floor for an elected office will be limited to presenting the name and Zonta club of the candidate. A seconder is needed.
- 9. A main motion shall be in writing signed by a seconder, sent immediately to the Governor.
